1. PHD SCHOLARSHIPS IN WATER RESOURCES

Applications are invited for PhD scholarships within the following seven subject areas:

- Integrating remote sensing and hydrological modeling for groundwater resources assessment and sustainable use in the North China Plains
- Inverse estimation of large-scale effective unsaturated hydraulic parameters using satellite based estimates of evapotranspiration
- Evapotranspiration measurements and modeling from leaf to landscape
- New principles for design of groundwater monitoring
- Geology and groundwater flow in buried valleys
- Costs and benefits of nutrient reductions to Danish water-bodies
- Optimal allocation of water and land resources at the catchment scale

Only **five** scholarships for **five** different research projects are available and they will be awarded according to the applicants' background and qualifications.
